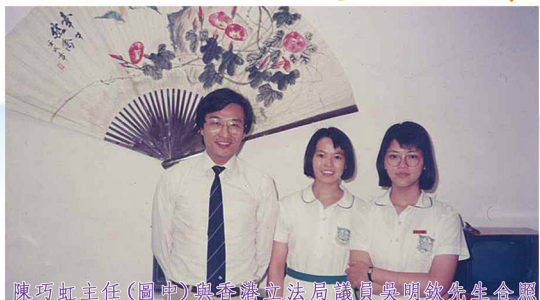
昔日校園生活

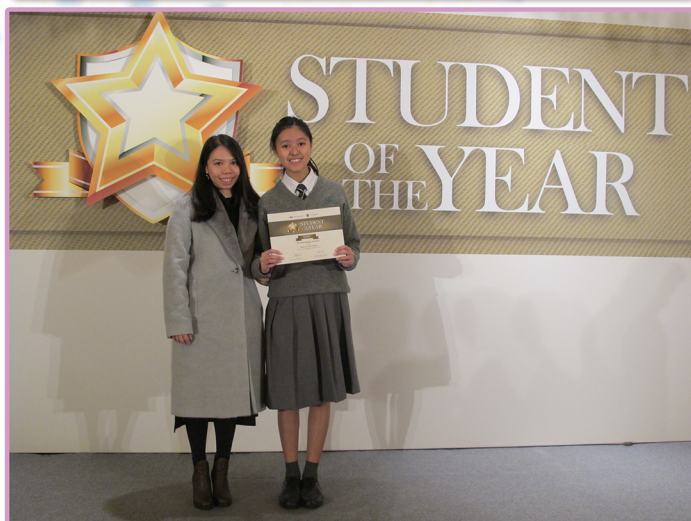
Association of Music Leaders
